Subject: How to Remove Virtual Readers by Command Line

The information in this article applies to: eToken RTE 3.60

Introduction: This article explains how to remove eToken virtual readers by command line.

How to steps:

Click Start->run:

rundll32 eTCoreReg.dll,CoreRemoveReaders X

Where X is the number of readers you have + 1 (e.g. is you have 2 readers, type 3).

Please note:

This command will remove all Aladdin virtual readers form the machine (AKS IFDH).

In order to add the readers after this operation you will need to manually add them from the eToken Properties interface.
